

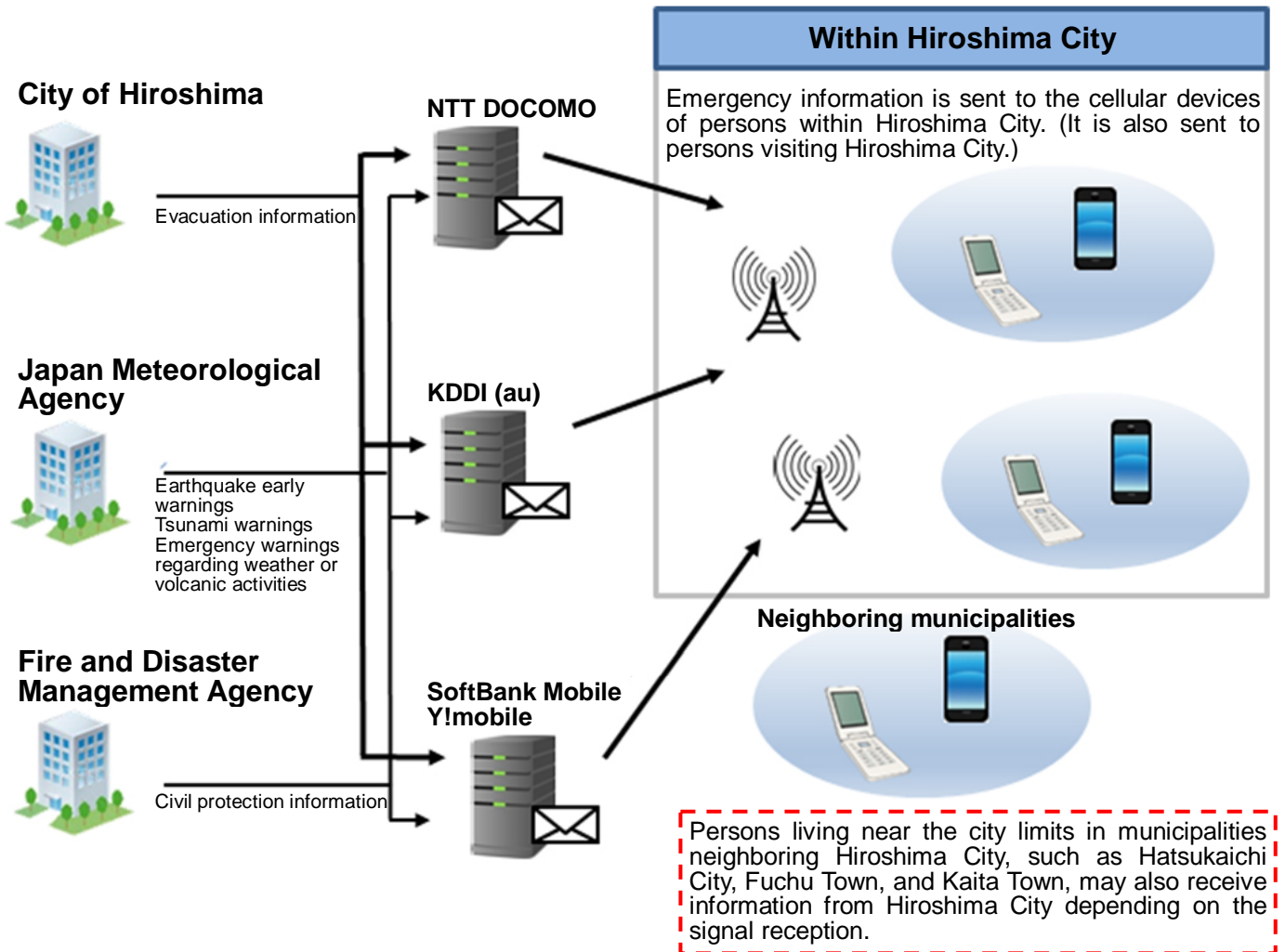


Emergency Alert E-mail

During an emergency, such as when a disaster may occur, Hiroshima City, the Japan Meteorological Agency, and the Fire and Disaster Management Agency send mass e-mails containing disaster and evacuation information to all cellular devices in a certain area. (*E-mails are sent in Japanese.)

Urgent information such as evacuation advisories or evacuation orders (emergency)
