

Notification of School Expense Subsidy System

The City of Hiroshima offers financial assistance for the required school supply and school lunch expenses for children studying at municipal elementary and junior high schools.

Families whose income is at or below the figures shown in the following table can apply for assistance. Please consult with us if your family has difficulty financing the expenses for sending your child to school.

(These figures are from FY2016. These figures are rough estimates, and some variations may apply based on household age distribution, etc.)

Size of household	Example of family structure (model)	Annual income (gross annual income)
2 people	Single parent (from his/her 20s to 30s) and one child (1 st year elementary school student)	Approx. 2.24 million yen (Approx. 3.46 million yen)
	Single parent (in his/her 40s) and one child (1 st year junior high school student)	Approx. 2.40 million yen (Approx. 3.68 million yen)
3 people	Married couple (from their 20s to 30s) and one child (1 st year elementary school student)	Approx. 2.86 million yen (Approx. 4.25 million yen)
	Married couple (in their 40s) and one child (1 st year junior high school student)	Approx. 3.00 million yen (Approx. 4.43 million yen)
4 people	Married couple (from their 20s to 30s) and two children (1 st year elementary school student and one infant)	Approx. 3.30 million yen (Approx. 4.80 million yen)
	Married couple (in their 40s) and two children (1 st year junior high school student and 3 rd year elementary school student)	Approx. 3.60 million yen (Approx. 5.18 million yen)

Note: Annual income is,

- for salaried workers, the value after employment income deduction from the withholding slip.
- for business income, the value after subtracting required expenses from annual earnings.

Target expense items for subsidy:

(1) School supplies, etc. (Figures for FY2016)

1 st year elementary school student:	12,990 yen
2 nd - 6 th year elementary school student:	15,220 yen
1 st year junior high school student:	24,590 yen
2 nd and 3 rd year junior high school student:	26,820 yen

(2) Supplies for new enrollment (Figures for FY2016)

1 st year elementary school student:	20,470 yen
1 st year junior high school student:	23,550 yen

- (3) School lunch, (4) School excursions, (5) Outdoor activities, and (6) School infirmary (Families receiving welfare benefits are subject to receiving subsidies for only school excursion and school infirmary expenses.)
