In order to aid in disaster prevention measures for our citizens, the City of Hiroshima **sends emergency and important disaster prevention information such as evacuation advisories by e-mail** to pre-registered cellular phones and PCs. (*E-mails are sent in Japanese.)








<<Addition of the Easy Registration Function>>


On January 28, 2016, we added the "かんたん登録" (Easy Registration) function, which allows you to register in just a few steps.

For the information to be sent which will be set automatically by the "かんたん登録" (Easy Registration,) see [here](#) .

- * This system can be used free of charge. However, separate communication fees do apply.
- * Announcements and cancellations of [emergency warnings](#), which the Japan Meteorological Agency began running on August 30, 2013 (Fri), are also sent to all registered users as emergency information. (However, this excludes "earthquake early warnings" and "eruption warnings" that are ranked as emergency warnings.)

Major Information Transmitted

Emergency warnings		<p>Evacuation preparation or for the elderly to begin evacuation, or evacuation advisories, evacuation orders (emergencies), etc.</p> <p>Emergency warnings announced by the City of Hiroshima (Heavy rain, storms, snowstorms, heavy snow, high waves, storm surges)</p> <p>Emergency warnings announced by Hiroshima Prefecture (Major tsunami warnings)</p>
Important information		<p>Important information regarding natural disasters or incidents/accidents</p>
Information about establishment or abolishment of disaster countermeasures headquarters		<p>Information about establishment or abolishment of disaster alert headquarters or disaster countermeasures headquarters in the City of Hiroshima (Ward)</p>
Crime prevention information		<p>Information regarding suspicious persons or crimes from Hiroshima Prefectural Police Headquarters</p>
Weather information		<p>Weather advisory / warning and sediment disaster alert information announced by the City of Hiroshima</p> <p>Record-breaking heavy rain information, tornado caution information announced by Hiroshima Prefecture</p>
Earthquake information and tsunami information		<p>Earthquake information for seismic intensity of 3 or above observed in south-western part of Hiroshima Prefecture</p> <p>Tsunami cautions / warnings announced by Hiroshima Prefecture</p>
River flooding forecasts		<p>Flood forecasts announced for flood forecasting rivers in Hiroshima City</p> <p>(Flood advisory information, flood alerting information, etc.)</p>

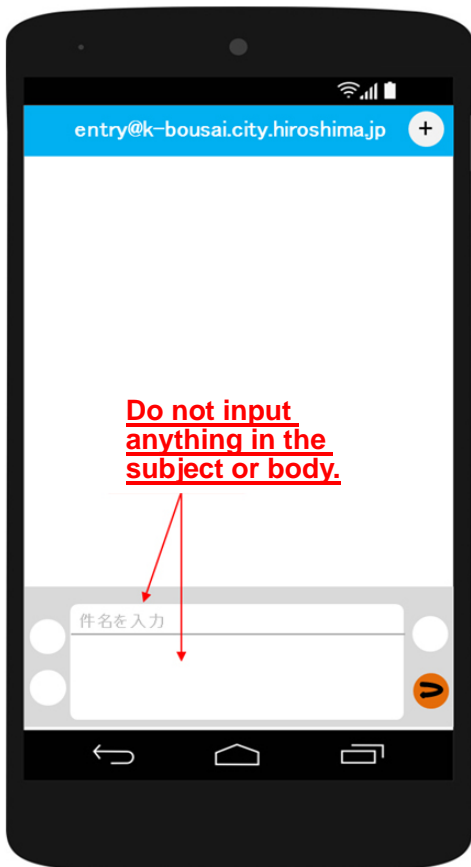

Registration Method

(1) Send a blank e-mail to the registration address.



If you would like to register, send a blank e-mail (e-mail without a subject or body) from cellular phone or PC where you would like to receive the e-mails to the registration address.

Users with a 2D barcode scanning cellular phone can acquire the registration e-mail address from the QR code on the right.

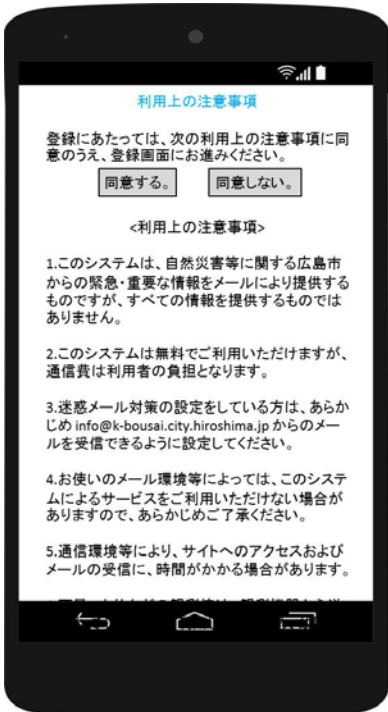


(2) Tap (or click) the URL in the e-mail delivered to you to connect to the registration homepage.

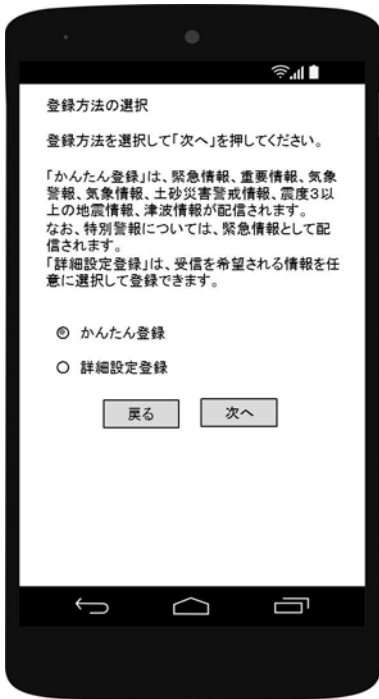


(3) Read the precautions for usage, then press the "同意する" button.




Press the "同意する" button.

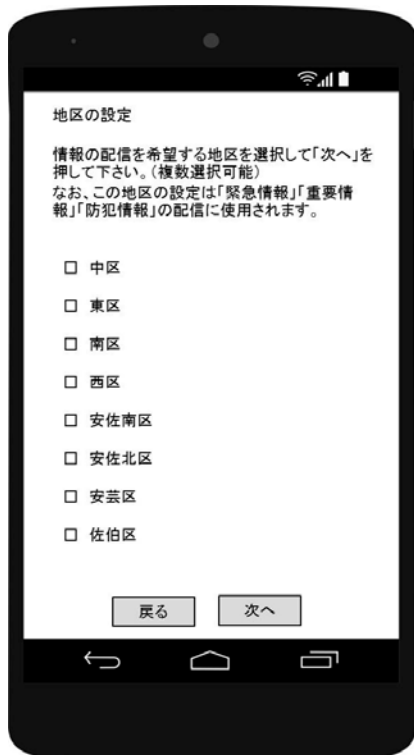
(4) Select a registration method then press the "次へ" button. (You can use "かんたん登録" (Easy Registration) to register in just a few steps.)



Press "次へ."

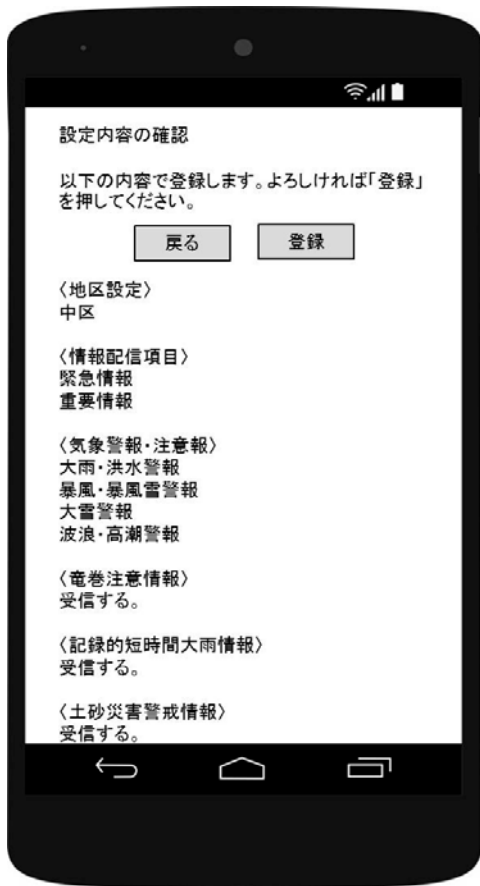
- *1. "かんたん登録" (Easy Registration) is selected by default.
- *2. For the information to be sent which will be set automatically by the "かんたん登録" (Easy Registration,) see [here](#) .
- *3. Use "詳細設定登録" (Detailed Setting Registration) to register by selecting only the information you want to be sent (emergency information is required).

(5) Select the area for which you want information to be sent, then press the "次へ" button. (You can select multiple options.)



Press the "次へ" button.

(6) Check the setting contents, then press the "登録" button.



Press the "登録" button.

(This completes the operation.)

After completing registration, if you would like to change the registration contents or cancel your registration, send a blank e-mail to the registration e-mail in the same way to do so.
